Uniform test → middle of the term

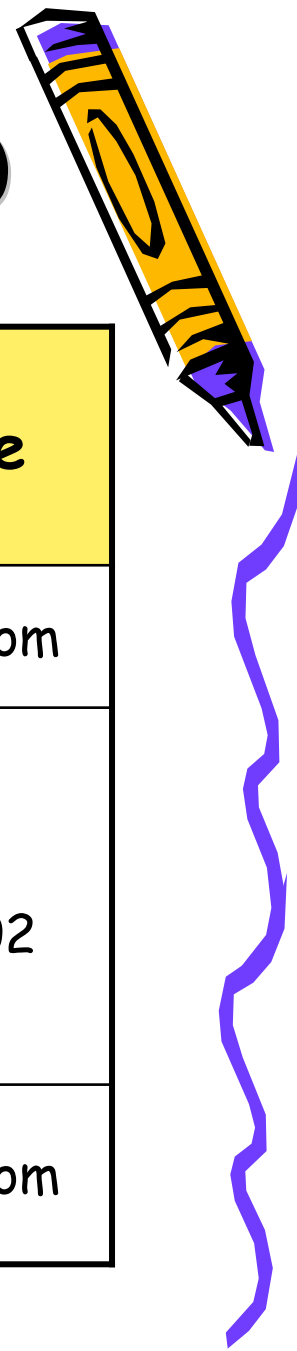
