Capacity of Student Affairs Committee (SAC) was empowered to derive a set of school based materials in delivering "Wisdom in Action programme" in junior form. Content and focus of all workshops were revised to better fit students' need. Cambridge Occupational Analysis will be introduced next year to all junior form students. Contents and scope of career guidance was expanded as to help students understand their own capabilities, career aspiration and to develop positive attitude towards work and learning.
