edge when applying for renowned universities abroad such as Harvard University, Stanford University and Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Accordingly, HLC offers a fast track curriculum to gifted students who obtain excellent results academically and complete MOOCs in designated subjects. Such scholars may skip one year in junior forms.

across forms and with teachers from different departments while simultaneously embracing diversity and individuality. The artistic process also


